Tenderers should take note of the following tender condition:

1. Failure to complete all supplementary/requested information will result in the Tender being deemed non responsive.
2. Tenderers are to familiarize themselves fully with the specifications and other portions of the Tender Document.
3. Tenderers must submit a Valid Original and in the Case of a Joint Venture, Tax Clearance Certificates of All Partners in the Joint Venture with their Tender in order to be considered.
4. Bidders must submit their latest Municipal account with the address corresponding to the company's address on CIPC registration document or a Lease Agreement
5. Bidders are required to, together with their bids; submit original and valid **B-BBEE Status Level Verification Certificate** or Certified copies thereof to substantiate their B-BBEE rating claims with **SANAS Logo, for Exempted Micro Enterprise** must submit a Certificate issued by registered auditors or accounting officers with practice number.
6. Tenders will be evaluated based on the Preferential Procurement Policy of the Municipality using the 90/10 points system. The lowest or any tender will not necessarily be accepted and the Municipality reserves the right to accept any tender wholly or partially.
